20. CONDITIONAL CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY APPROVED

21. LONGBOAT HARBOUR MARINA APPLICATION DISCUSSED

Commissioner Sedwick said it had been brought to his attention that some of the residents of Longboat Harbour had received requests from the Corps of Engineers for their opinions about possible construction of marinas at Longboat Harbour. The Commission opinion was that such construction plans had been deleted from the plot plans when presented, and the deletion initialed by Mr. Mann. Therefore, no permit had ever been issued by the Town and there was a question as to propriety of seeking such a permit from the Corps of Engineers, if such be the case.


22. BICENTENNIAL PLANS DISCUSSED
