Here are some photos of the flooding from 2023. I have many more but these show the depth. We had 3-5 inches of water in our house during these two events. Had to replace a Dryer at each residence and a dishwasher at 7025. Other damage was handled by my son and I. He lives at the 7049 Residence. Water came over our sea walls. By our estimation, the water was a elevation 4.5 ft. (18" above his seawall because we had a cinder block on the wall upright and the water was over that).

BTW- Streets were flooded last week from the High Tide. I have phots of that if you are interested.
