Chief & Tina,

HV103 and HB 983 were passed during the 2024 Legislative Session and will become law effective July 1, 2024. These bills create additional categories of position and personal exemptions from public records requests for personnel information held by employer that is shared with another agency (FRS) under section 119.071(4)(d)3, Florida Statues (F.S.). A notarized request for exemption with a statement under oath attesting to the statutory basis for the exemption must be provided to the Custodial Agency which is (FRS).

I have attached an Employee-Specific Public Records Exemption form along with a list of FRS members who need to complete, notarize and return to Human Resources by Friday, July 5, 2024
