At the Nov. meeting of the Village Association the suggestion was made to use funds of the association to install benches at bay accesses in the Village.

We would like to object to a bench being placed at the access adjacent to our property at the end of Russell Street. The reasons are :

- a) Unlike some other bay accesses in the Village which cannot be used because they are obstructed by vegetation, this access is used (by fishermen, boaters and walkers). We do not wish to have any additional activity next to our house. A bench at this place might attract more people and encourage lengthy stays, especially on weekends.
- b) There are, in our opinion, enough places on the bay where people can spend time: the dock at the end of Broadway, the village pier on Bayside Drive (with the Arends bench next to it).
