The Citizens Tax Oversight Committee held its annual meeting on June 7, 2017 at 9:30am at 501 Bay Isles Road in the Commission Chamber and reviewed the following:

1. Audited Results

The Budget Analyst reviewed the 2016 audited results of operations with the Citizens' Tax Oversight Committee which showed that the fund balance decreased \$608,845 for a total fund balance of \$853,205 as follows:
